FISHING FOR EVERY SEASON

NUMBER ONE SHORE FISHING LAKE!

Devils Lake grew from 40,000 acres 30 years ago to nearly four times that size now. That means hundreds of shoreline miles and as many shore-fishing opportunities for fishermen.

The lake boasts more places to catch walleyes, pike, white bass and perch from shore than any other lake in the United States. Roads cut off with rising water were built up with rip-rap boulders; the adjacent deep water attracts fish and fishermen.

Anglers enjoy some of the finest lawn-chair fishing anywhere. Spring pike and walleye fishing from shore is a neighborly, family affair as soon as the ice pulls away from the shorelines. Fishing season is open year-round. That could be why one-quarter of all statewide non-resident 3-day and 10-day fishing licenses are sold in Devils Lake.


Always cognizant of the lure of fishing, the community with state and

Paul Bunyan and thousands of his Minnesota friends love to fish Devils Lake. So do people from all over the country because there is no closed season, fish limits are generous and something – perch, walleyes, pike or white bass – always seems to be biting.

SPRING & SUMMER

Fisheries, biologists and anglers alike know that numbers of foot-long and larger perch are at record numbers. Pike of the line-stretching variety are big and hungry. Regional biologists say, "Eat more pike." With pike averaging nearly five pounds, anglers can expect to catch 10-pounders and many trophies.

Walleyes are the main attraction with all sizes present from "eaters" to wall-hangers. Visiting anglers love fishing for walleyes on Devils Lake because they can fish just like they do back home - slip bobbers, rigging, jigging, casting or trolling crank baits, and pulling bottom bouncers with spinners. Open-water walleye action begins at ice-out, but picks up lake-wide in June with no summer doldrums. Walleyes bite and are caught best in June, July and August. Fall is trophy time. The fourth main species, white bass, reaches bragging size of three to four pounds and bite year-round. Then, the ice season takes over and the fish keep biting.



local funding, built special fishing ramps/ docks for physically impaired and elderly fishermen. These piers have been installed at popular fishing locations: Channel A, Henegar Landing, Pike Playground and Fishing Pier, and at Creel Bay's Lakewood Beach.

Steps were constructed last summer over the rip-rap at the Highway 57 bridge, making one additional, relatively easy access for shorecasters.

With or without a boat (or with a guide), from shore or out in the middle of the lake, anglers have more hotspots to fish than ever before. Walleye and pike limits are five daily and 10 in possession. Cleaning stations (free to the public) are conveniently located around the lake and even in the city itself. Specifics are located on the website: devilslakend.com.

ICE FISHING

Devils Lake is the number one destination for North American ice anglers. More than 15,000 fishermen head onto the ice with guides each winter. Thousands more travel to north-central North Dakota for their DIY fishing adventures.

Zippy Dahl, founder of the world-famous Perch Patrol, said, "Perch fishing was great last year; it should be even better this winter. Hiring a guide is like a short-cut because our guides are on the ice daily." Summer fisheries' crews recorded 18.3 perch per survey net compared to the long-term average of 11.5. This winter is shaping up to be a good one. Walleyes per net were 32.4; the average is 21 per net.

Most visitors book fishing and lodging via resorts, motels or guide services where everything is provided including tackle, shelters, fish-finding electronics, fishing tips, bait and on-ice transportation. Details: devilslakend.com.

TV host Jason Mitchell loves perch and walleyes but reminded

Devils Lake anglers to consider northern pike. "Pike over 40 inches are caught every season. Make a pike party." Pike are always hungry!

Respected fishing promoter and ice fishing professor Brian "Bro" Brosdahl said, "This is one place where I know a number of species of true trophy size can be caught in a day."

Guide Ancil Reynolds said, "This winter will showcase the lake's 12-to-14-inch jumbo perch and big pike. Until clients run for tipups all day long, they don't realize how much fun northern pike can be."

Limits are generous with 20 perch daily; 40 in possession. Pike and walleye limits are five daily and 10 in possession. Seasons never close on Devils Lake. The area motels, resorts and community have the most indoor, heated fish-cleaning stations per capita than any other locale.

This winter experience what the rest of the fishing world already knows – ice fishing is one more reason to add Devils Lake to your Bucket List.

ANS SURCHARGE FEES

Starting back in 2020, a surcharge will be added to certain game and watercraft licenses to support the Aquatic Nuisance Species Program Fund. All boats licensed in North Dakota will include this surcharge when renewing the license. Boats not licensed in North Dakota are required to pay an annual fee and display an ANS sticker to legally operate watercraft on state waters. **This can be purchased at https://gf.nd.gov**

AQUATIC NUISANCE SPECIES

Help preserve our lake and prevent transfer of Aquatic Nuisance Species (ANS). Wash your boat, trailer, and pickup prior to entering Devils Lake. Also, to keep other organisms from spreading into our lake, clean and disinfect your live wells and other places lake water accumulates. Your cooperation is appreciated.

FISHING REGULATION HIGHLIGHTS

- A fishing year is defined as April 1 in any calendar year through March 31 of the following calendar year.
- The licensee shall carry the fishing license on his/her person at all times while fishing.
- Any nonresident under the age of 16 years may take and possess a limit of fish without a nonresident license if accompanied by an adult possessing a valid fishing license.
- ND law permits the use of boats legally numbered under the numbering system of another state for a period of 90 days.
- Ice houses are no longer required to be licensed. An unoccupied house does require identification. The house must display on its outside, in characters at least 3 inches high, owner's name and address or phone number.
- All aquatic vegetation must be removed from boats, personal watercraft, trailers, and fishing and hunting equipment such as fishing poles, bait buckets, lures, duck decoys, and waders, before leaving a body of water. That means "vegetation free" when transporting watercraft and/or equipment away from a boat ramp, landing area or shoreline.
- · Live aquatic bait or aquatic vegetation may not be transported into North Dakota.
- · All water must be drained from boats and other watercraft, including bilges, live wells, baitwells and motors before leaving a body of water.
- All drain plugs that may hold back water must be removed, and water draining devices must be open on all watercraft and recreational, commercial and construction equipment bilges and confined spaces during any out-of-water transport of same.
- All water must be drained from bait buckets as anglers leave the shore or remove their boats from the water. Anglers must properly dispose of unused bait away from the river, as dumping bait in the water or on shore is illegal. In all other waters not infested with Class I ANS species, anglers can transport live bait in water in containers of five (5) gallons or less in volume.

WATERFOWL HUNTING

Before the advent of excellent fishing, Devils Lake was known for decades as a duck and goose hunting destination. Hunters driving from Minnesota, Illinois and other states drove their Ford Model T's for several days over rough roads in the early 1900's for some of the best Midwestern waterfowl flights. That tradition continues (except for the Model T).

Today, they traverse highways at 70 mph and arrive refreshed for hunts the next day. "Devils Lake is one of the best waterfowl spots anywhere," said Kyle Blanchfield, operator of the oldest continuous duck/goose hunting service in North Dakota for three decades. He owns Woodland Resort and caters to hunters and fishermen.

Hunters usually chase waterfowl early, and with the "Cast & Blast" guided trips, they switch gears to afternoon and evening walleye fishing. Early duck season occurs in fields, potholes and back-bays for local ducks. The main lake attracts diving ducks. After mid-October, the fun begins with the arrival of flocks and flocks of snow geese. With liberal limits, snow goose





hunting provides amazing action. Canada geese are also part of the hunt.

Most resorts and lodges provide qualified guided hunts. Packages include guides who scout and set-up hundreds of decoys in advance of the day's hunt, plus meals and lodging. The website **devilslakend.com** contains a complete listing of guides, lodging and the status of duck and goose flights.

LICENSING SALES

For information about nonresident hunting licenses, visit http://gf.nd.gov/licenses/.

Hunter education is required for anyone born after 1961. Be sure to have a copy of your hunter education certificate handy when applying for a license. Nonresidents under the age of 16 from the states of MN, MI, MS, TN, TX and CO can buy North Dakota hunting licenses at resident prices because their states offer the same opportunity to North Dakota youth.

NEW ELECTRONIC ACCESS APP

Electronic posting of private land is now available in North Dakota. This makes it easy for hunters to determine the status of land (open or closed) as well as the owner. With that information, hunters may contact the owner when requesting permission to hunt.

There are two map applications, the PLOTS Guide viewer and the ArcGIS Explorer app. Posted lands are in dark orange crosshatch. Clicking on the parcel will display the individual who posted the land and may include additional contact details.

The PLOTS Guide map mobile app does not require cell service. Once uploaded, the app allows hunters to view location, posted lands, public lands and PLOTS tracts. Go to gf.nd.gov to upload the PLOTS app. The ArcGIS app requires cell service.

Landowners may also post with signs. If the land is entirely enclosed by a fence, posting of signs at gates constitutes a posting of the entire parcel. **The North Dakota code is simple, "Ask permission first."**

The causeway to the Park stretches for miles and is a favorite shoreline fishing destination.

Take in the Plummer's Store and stroll the wooden boardwalks. Stop at the Interpretive Center Gift Shop or check out the Traveling Exhibits. And why not complete the experience? The downtown Devils Lake area is a historic monument to its origins from the 1880s. The charm of turn-of-the-century brick and design is seen on the buildings lining Main Street. Take a walking tour and view 59 buildings on the National Historic Register.

Stop in to investigate the Lake Region Heritage Center, museum and art gallery that houses the unique history of the Lake Region. Displays include the Old Post Office, Life of the Lake: Devils Lake, The Federal Courtroom and other unique displays.

The Sheriff's House Museum is a stop where you can step back in time. It features parlors, kitchen and dining rooms, five bedrooms that have changed little from the time the residence was occupied in 1911. It also features exhibits narrating and interpreting the history of Devils Lake.
